WOOSTER, OHIO --- Ohio's number one collegiate soccer team, the University of Akron, dominated the All-Ohio soccer team with three first team players.

The Zips one-two scoring punch of George and Louie Nanchoff were chosen to the first team and joined by defenseman Nick LeGrande. Senior goalie Paul Dueker was chosen to the second team.

A senior, George Nanchoff scored 12 goals with 12 assists during the 1976 season. An All-America choice last year, Nanchoff received the Carl Dale Memorial Award as Ohio's best offensive player of the year for the second straight season. This is Nanchoff's third straight selection to the All-Ohio first team.

A second team All-Ohio choice last year, LeGrande captured the Carl Dale Memorial Award as Ohio's best defensive player of the year.

Dayton placed All-American forward Bob Rohrback on the first team for the second straight year. Rohrback led all collegiate soccer players in the state last year and tied the College of Wooster's Key Akintunde with 21 goals for the 1976 season.

Akintunde, who has 43 career goals though playing fullback half of his freshman year, was also named to the first team. The junior was joined on the line by Mount Union's Sam Williams. Williams led the Purple Raiders to their second straight 9-1 season.

Defensively, Cleveland State and Ohio Wesleyan placed two first team performers. The Vikings, rated second in Ohio in the final poll of the season, had Alan Jefferis and James Paynter chosen.

Ohio Wesleyan, Ohio Conference champions, placed seniors Don Minkler and Jeff Hoch. Hoch is the second straight Bishop goalie chosen to the first team though playing varsity for his first year.

Miami University's Bruce Netzler was the final defenseman chosen.

Cleveland State had three players selected to the second team, Bob Hritz, Alex Rosul, and Hassan Rezaie. Oberlin placed Tony Osei and Ohio Wesleyan John Spofford on the forward line. Cedarville's Evrando Batista completed the attacking line.

The defensive line consisted of Kent State's Joe Burwell, Wooster's Kevin Kolich, and Mount Union's Earl Chase.
